TWO Cork lifeboat crews have been recognised for their bravery.

The awards were issued at Farmleigh House, Phoenix Park.

Kinsale RNLI was recognised for its bravery in rescuing fishermen in gale force conditions last April.

A 20-metre beam trawler was forced onto the rocks at a point at the entrance to the harbour at about 6pm on Tuesday.

Less than five minutes after receiving its call, Kinsale RNLI located the vessel on the rocks with three metres of water breaking over its deck.

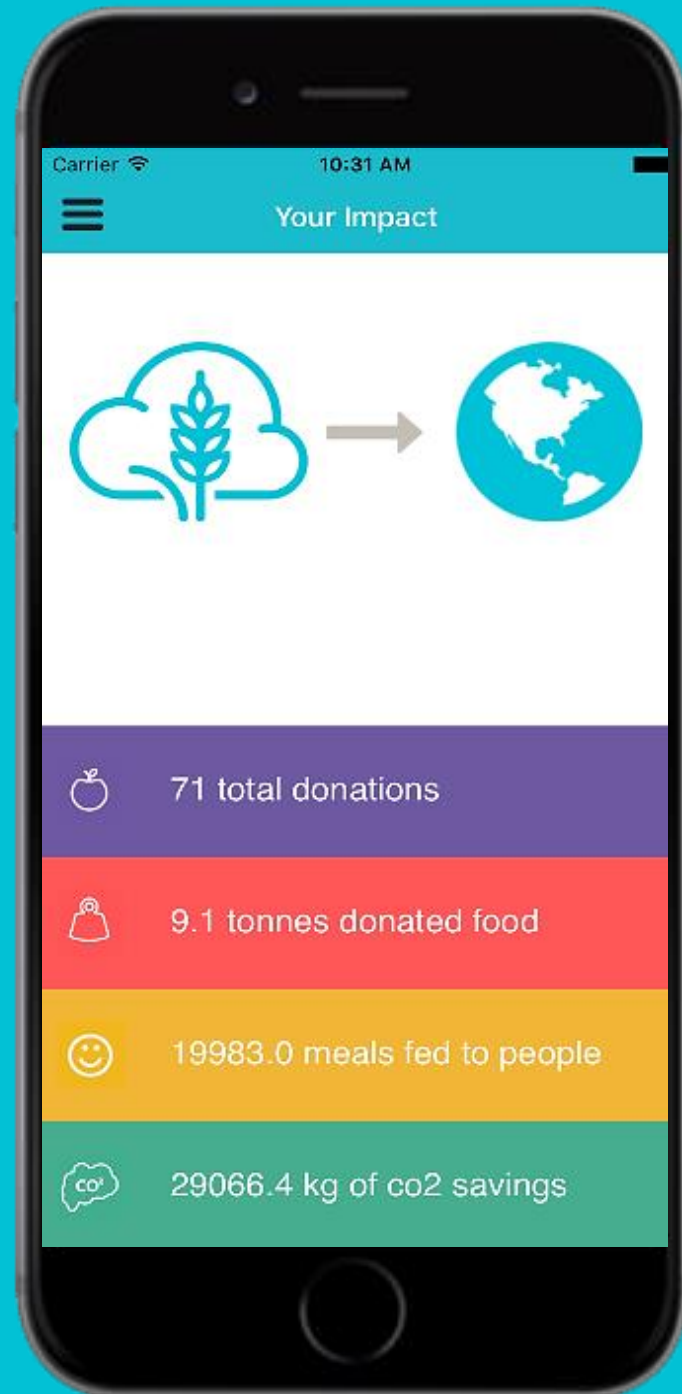
The experienced crew, led by Helm Nick Searis, managed to bring the vessel back to the harbour.

Tesco's 70,000 charity meals

LOCAL charities across Cork have received almost 70,000 meals from a food donations programme supported by Tesco.

The supermarket giant has been supporting the food surplus organisation, FoodCloud, which donates to organisations including Cork Foyer, Mahon Youth Development Project and O'Connell Court, which have benefited from the redistribution of over 31,000 kgs of surplus food from Tesco stores across Cork since 2014.

Aoife Dilworth, Area Community Champion for Tesco in Cork, said: "My day-to-day role involves working with the charities and FoodCloud to ensure our partners are receiving food which works for them. I have seen the impact that this initiative has on these organisations and I am delighted to play a role."

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS



SDG 12.3: “By 2030, halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains, including post-harvest losses.”



- a. Record product level data:** Integration with current food waste recording device or automatic email of current record produced for stock control
- b. Direct weighing:** Using a measuring device to determine the weight of FLW
- c. Assessing volume:** Choose a standard container to donate surplus food (eg. Crates) to assess the physical space occupied by FLW, and use the result to determine the weight using a standard calculation.

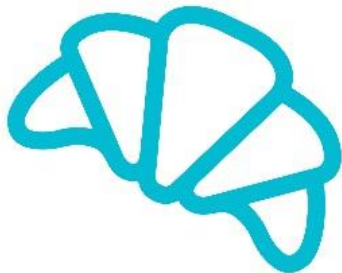
The accurate and consistent measurement of food data, including donated food, can provide a basis for identifying prevention options, setting reduction targets and tracking progress over time.

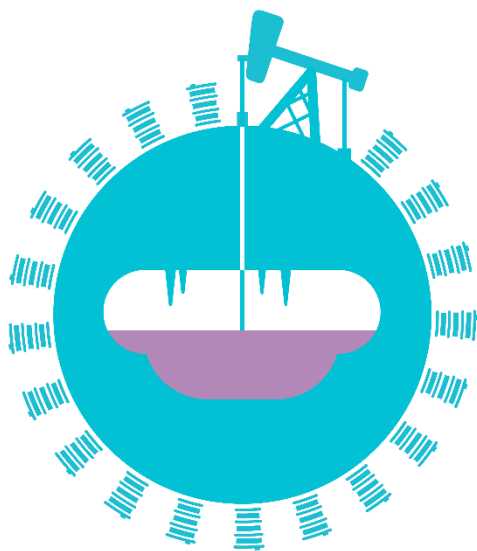

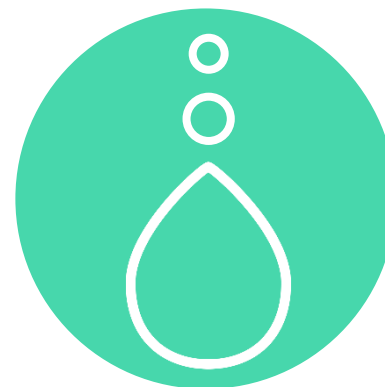
